

Advanced workshop for Feldenkrais Method® practitioners, led by Susanne Braun

November 20 – 22 in Amsterdam

We live, breathe and act in the multi-layered world that surrounds us. We are in constant dialogue with the world, we are at one with it, we cannot exist without it. Self-development only makes sense if it also brings about real changes in our relationship with our surroundings. The exploration of the dynamic dialogues between the inner and outer world is an area of application of the method that is often rather in the background.

DYNAMIC DIALOGUES 1: DIALOGUES IN GRAVITY

This is part 1 of a three-part Advanced Training that highlights various aspects of these dynamic interactions. This first part explores being in gravity and our communication with supporting surfaces. Among the various aspects of the role of the ground in the Feldenkrais Method, this Advanced Training focuses on communication with the supporting surface as a potential for movement and action. We explore how a more differentiated dialogue with these surfaces leads to the development of qualities in thinking, feeling and acting. The creation of a living relationship with the floor can be experienced as a resource for ATM, FI, and in our teaching skills.

Part 2 (dialogue with the senses) and part 3 (spatial dialogues) will be considered for the future.

Susanne Braun worked for 30 years as a freelance dancer, choreographer and dance teacher in Europe and the USA. She graduated 2005 as a Feldenkrais Practitioner under the guidance of Elizabeth Beringer. She has been a Feldenkrais Trainer since 2025, having previously accompanied various professional Feldenkrais trainings in Europe as an Assistant Trainer. Susanne runs her own dance studio and Feldenkrais practice near Zürich, Switzerland. A lifelong passion for movement, her interest in somatic learning processes, and her love for people – in their connectedness and uniqueness, characterize her teaching. She lives with her partner and two dogs.
